### **Alcoholic Beverages**

Alcoholic Beverages are not permitted in the park without prior city approval. A \$1,000,000 liability insurance policy and Liquor Use Agreement must be submitted and approved by the Board of Aldermen. Public Safety Officers are required to be present. State and City Licenses may also be required.

### **Animals**

Domestic animals must be kept on a leash. No catching or killing of wildlife permitted.

### **Archaeology**

Renner Brenner Park is on the National Register of Historic Places and is a protected archaeological preserve as designated by the United States Department of the Interior. No surface collecting, digging, metal detecting or any removal of any types of artifacts allowed.

### **Camping**

Camping is not allowed.

### **Firearms and Fires**

Firearms, including bow and arrows, and fires are prohibited in the park.

### **Hours of Use**

The park is open from dawn to dusk, except by special permission. Public Safety closes the park at dusk.

### **Parking**

The parking lot will hold approximately 20 cars. Additional parking is available across the street in the City Hall or Community Center parking lots.

### **Property**

Do not mark, deface, disfigure, injure, tamper or displace any park property.

### **Public Safety Fee**

If your event requires public safety officers present, the fee is \$50 per hour per officer.

### **Rubbish**

All trash must be placed in the containers provided or removed from the park.

### **Sales-Rental Signs**

Selling or renting any goods, services, equipment or facilities is prohibited. No signs, placards or ads may be posted in or adjacent to the park, except to give directions to your group and must be immediately removed afterwards.

### **Traffic**

All vehicles must stay on the parking lot. Driving through the park is not allowed.

### **Trees and Plants**

Do not damage, cut, transplant, remove or injure any plant or tree. Do not attach rope or other contrivance to any tree or plant.

### **Shelter and Park Lighting**

The shelter house, gazebo and amphitheater are lighted. The shelter house and the amphitheater have electrical outlets that remain "hot" 24 hours a day. All the lights in the park are on automatic timers and shut off well after dusk.
