

**RIVERSIDE PARK BOARD MEETING
MINUTES**

August 1, 2006
6:00 p.m.

The Riverside Park Board held their regularly scheduled meeting at the Community Center in Riverside, Missouri, on Wednesday, August 1, 2006. The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. Those in attendance were: Jim Frakes, Kathy Rose, Lori Rardeen, Julie Rule, Brent Miles and Jane Henry.

Community Center

Rardeen reported on recent events at the community center.

WSKF – Miles told the park board about the board of aldermen’s commitment of \$20,000 for an initial design concept and needs assessment for the proposed community center expansion. Miles asked Rardeen to quantify the usage of the CC, detailed where possible, and get it to him as soon as possible. Also, under consideration will be remodeling the annex and Public Works.

Line Creek Trail – Comments from the Levee District came in today. Miles said the City needs an agreement with the Levee District asking to use their levee. The City will make a presentation to the Levee District on August 10.

Missouri Riverfront Trail – The City and the Levee District are close to reaching an agreement on usage, maintenance, etc., of this trail.

E. H. Young Park Sewer – The issue is on BOA’s agenda tonight. If approved, bids could go out next week.

Homestead Park – The survey of the property will be completed today. The fence can then be constructed.

At this point in the meeting, Miles, Rose and Henry had to leave to attend the board of aldermen meeting in the BOA Chambers.
