City Codes You Need to Know

Now that spring is approaching and the weather is warming, it's time to brush up on some of the city codes that Riverside residents are required to follow:

- Grass should be mowed at a height no higher than 10".
- Pools deeper than 24" require a fence.
- Trash receptacles are to be kept out of sight.
- Don't feed feral cats.
- All deck and fence additions require permits.
- Don't leave bulky items, leaves and brush at the curb. These items can be taken to Purcell Yard Waste Recycling Facility at 6305 NW Riverpark Drive.

Riverside Helps Citizens Shape Up

Residents Get Discounts at Local Fitness Centers

You've probably heard that exercise provides many health benefits, and the average American doesn't get enough of it. To combat the trend, Riverside is committed to helping its citizens stay fit. As part of the Healthy Citizens Initiative, the City offers Riverside residents a 75% discount on memberships to participating fitness centers. The offer is valid at the Platte County Community Center (YMCA), the Gladstone Community Center and the North Kansas City Community Center.



To sign up for the North Kansas City or Gladstone centers, go to either location and purchase a single or family membership. You will have to pay the full membership cost up front, and can purchase up to a six

month membership at a time. To receive the discount, go to the Riverside Community Center and fill out a Request for Reimbursement form. You'll need a copy of your driver's license, a utility bill with your name and Riverside address, and your membership receipt. The city will verify your address and issue your 75% reimbursement by mail.

To sign up at the Platte County Community Center (YMCA), go to the location and purchase a single or family membership. You will need to pay the 25% fee up front. Provide a copy of your driver's license and a utility bill with your name and address, and the YMCA will send your residency information to the city for verification. Your membership will be valid at all metro YMCAs.


