

Riverside Selects New City Administrator

Brian Koral Begins April 23

After reviewing 43 applicants from 17 states, the City of Riverside Board of Aldermen announced the hiring of Brian Koral as City Administrator. Koral will replace Greg Mills, who is retiring after almost 14 years of service to the City of Riverside. Originally hired as the Director of Public Safety, Greg has spent the past five years as City Administrator.



Brian Koral has served as Town Administrator for the city of Atoka, Tennessee since June 2011. During his tenure, the town expanded its focus to provide municipal services while maintaining one of the lowest municipal property tax rates in the region. Major initiatives included the launch of the parks and recreation and fire departments, the construction of the new municipal complex, road resurfacing, park upgrades and more.

"After an extensive search process for a new city administrator, we are excited to welcome Brian Koral to our Riverside family," Mayor Kathy Rose said. "Brian will be a great addition to city hall and to our community and looks forward to embracing what 'upstream from ordinary' truly means."

Fireworks Allowed

June 26-July 2, July 5 - 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.

July 3 & 4 - 10 a.m. to midnight

It's the Law

- Shooting fireworks on City property, including City parks, is strictly prohibited.
- Bottle rockets are prohibited.
- Fireworks may not be used within 600 feet of churches, schools, public library or day cares; within 300 feet of a structure where fireworks are stored or offered for sale; within 300 feet of gasoline pumps, propane tanks, flammable liquids or solids or a structure marked with flammable or water reactive.
